 An act relating to the Hillsborough County Public
 Transportation Commission; abolishing the commission;
 repealing chs. 98-451, 2001-299, 2007-297, 2008-290,
 2010-265, 2010-272, and 2012-247, Laws of Florida;
 transferring assets and liabilities of the commission
 to the Board of County Commissioners of Hillsborough
 County; amending ch. 2000-445, Laws of Florida, as
 amended; correcting a cross reference; providing an
 effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Chapters 98-451, 2001-299, 2007-297, 2008-290, 2010-265, 2010-272, and 2012-247, Laws of Florida, are repealed.

Section 2. The Hillsborough County Public Transportation Commission is abolished. All assets and liabilities of the commission are transferred to the Board of County Commissioners of Hillsborough County.

Section 3. Subsection (1) of section 4 of chapter 2000-445, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapter 2014-230, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 4. Application.—

(1) The provisions of this act apply to all classified personnel employed by the following agencies or authorities
