


# Water Systems Continued

# Sampling, Testing & Monitoring

- Operations teams working together
- Monitoring corrosion parameters – Alkalinity and pH
- Finished water tested more frequently than required





# Additional Assurances

- State-certified Lab
- 340 monitoring sites
- 328 samples collected monthly
- 29,916 water quality tests yearly
- Oversight By FL Department of Health





# Additional Assurances Continued

The testing is in addition to testing that Tampa Bay Water, City of Tampa and Plant City do prior to providing water to Hillsborough County
